Status and Amendments

1. PABX Communications C.C. respects your privacy and is committed to the voluntary privacy protection principles contained in Chapter 8 of the Electronic Communications and Transactions Act.
2. This privacy policy statement sets out our information gathering and dissemination practices.
3. This Privacy Policy forms part of the Terms and Conditions of Use of this web site. If you do not agree with this Policy then you may not use this web site and are required to cease doing so immediately.
4. The web site owner reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy at any time. While the web site owner will attempt to flag changes to this Policy as and when implemented, users remain at all times responsible for ensuring that they are aware of the current terms of this Policy whenever accessing this web site, and continued use of the site subsequent to any amendments having been affected constitutes users' acceptance of the Policy as amended.



Collection of personal data

5. PABX Communications C.C. is dedicated to offering you the ultimate data protection solution. Where personal information (such as your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address and credit card information) is submitted to the site by the user, for example through sending an e-mail or filling in required fields, the following principles are observed in the handling of that information:
 - a. This web site collects, processes and stores only such personal information regarding users as is necessary to provide the services offered. The specific purpose for which information is collected is apparent from the context in which it is requested.
 - b. In accordance with the data protection solution this web site will not use the personal information submitted for any other purpose other than the efficient provision of services, including this web site and services offered

- through it by third parties, without obtaining the prior written approval of the user or unless required to do so by law.
- c. This web site will keep records of all personal information collected and the specific purpose for which it was collected for a period of one year from the date on which it was last used.
 - d. This web site will not disclose any personal information regarding a user to any third party unless the prior written agreement of the user is obtained or the web site is required or permitted to do so by law.
 - e. If information is released with the user's consent this web site will retain a record of the information released, the third party to which it was released, the reason for the release and the date of release, for a period of one year.
 - f. This web site will destroy or delete any personal information under its control which has become obsolete.
6. Information collected about users through their use of this web site and newsletter service is the property of the web site owner.
 7. The web site owner will retain all ownership of and copyright in any database of users' personal information submitted to or collected by this web site or any service offered through it.
 8. The web site owner will not utilise personal and other information submitted by users through the use of this web site in order to provide further information about the web site and related services unless users have expressly given prior permission.

 11. Note that, as permitted by the ECT Act, this web site may use personal information collected to compile profiles for statistical purposes and trade in these profiles. No information contained in the profiles or statistics will be able to be linked to any specific user.



Collection of anonymous data

12. In order to provide the best possible and most relevant service, this web site utilises cookies. A cookie is a small file that is placed on the user's hard drive in order to keep a record of a user's interaction with this web site and facilitate user convenience.
 - a. Cookies from this web site allow the web site owner to tailor advertising and other services to your displayed preferences. The web site may use third party cookies from an adserver for this purpose.
 - b. Cookies by themselves will not be used to personally identify users but will be used to compile anonymised statistics relating to use of services offered or to provide us with feedback on the performance of this web site.

- c. The following classes of information will be collected in respect of users who have enabled cookies:
 - i. The browser used;
 - ii. IP address;
 - iii. Date and time of activities while visiting the web site;
 - iv. URLs of internal pages visited; and,
 - v. Referrers.
13. If a user does not wish cookies to be employed to customize his or her interaction with this web site it is possible to alter the manner in which their browser handles cookies. Please note that, if this is done, certain services on this web site may not be available.



User access to and management of personal data
